NOTES

SECTION 43 provides for the allowance of 80% charitable rate relief on a rated property which is occupied by or by trustees for a "charity" and which is wholly or mainly used for charitable purposes.

CHARITY means an institution or other organisation established for charitable purposes only. The charity does not need to be registered.

SECTION 47 provides for the allowance of up to 100% charitable relief for organisations falling outside the provisions of Section 43, or in addition to it, at the discretion of the local authority. Such allowances are reviewed annually.

Applications under this Section may be made by an organisation, occupying rated property, which is not established or conducted for profit and whose main object is:

(a) Charitable, philanthropic, religious or concerned with education, social welfare , science

(b) A club,society or other organisation established and conducted wholly or mainly for recreational purposes.

Applications should be accompanied by the following documents:

1. Copy of the Memorandum and Articles of Association, or Rules of the Association.

(These will be returned after the application has been considered)

2. Copies of the audited accounts and balance sheets for the last 2 years.

Community Amateur Sports Club - To register, you will need to apply to the Inland Revenue Sports Club Unit.
