1. The Card must be shown every time you wish to receive an advertised discount. If you do not show the card, you will be charged the full activity price.
2. The Card is valid for 12 months. The expiry date will be stated on the card. Once the card has expired, you may re-apply provided you are still eligible and can produce the necessary, up to date, documents.
3. The Card can only be used by the person whose name and photo appear on the card.
4. Any amended or defaced cards will be deemed invalid.
5. Any cards lost or damaged may be replaced at a cost of £2 to the applicant for each card. The expiry date of the replacement card will be the same as the old card.
6. The Card remains the property of the issuing Centre. The Management have the right to withdraw the card and the benefits of the Card from any person who does not conform to any of the above conditions or abuses the staff or facilities.

ABOUT THE CARD

What does the card do?

The Card allows the holder to take part in some activities at Alton Sports Centre, Taro Leisure Centre and Mill Chase Leisure Centre at a reduced price.

Who can have one?

Anyone who lives in East Hampshire District and falls into at least one of the eligibility categories listed in this leaflet can apply for a card.



How much does the card cost?

The Card is free. However you will need to provide a passport sized photograph of the holder. If you lose the card, you will need to pay £2 (and provide another photograph) to get a replacement.

What are the activities and how much will they cost?

The activities included in the scheme and the cost will be displayed in the Leisure Centres. These are reviewed every year but will always include casual swimming and casual gym sessions.

How long is the Card valid for?

12 months from the date of issue. After this time, if you are still eligible, you may apply for a new card. You will have to provide another photograph and show up to date proof that you are still eligible.



Are there any other benefits?

Other local venues/organisations may also be happy to give you a discount on production of your card; however this is entirely at their discretion and out of our control.

Bohunt School, Liphook (Tel: 01428 724324) and Horndean Technology College (Tel: 02392 599753) have agreed to give a discount to card holders for some sports activities – please contact them direct for information.

What types of card are there?

Junior (3-15 years)
Adult (16-59 years)
Senior (60-79 years)

Eligible adults may apply for cards for their dependent children (aged under 20) living at the same address.
