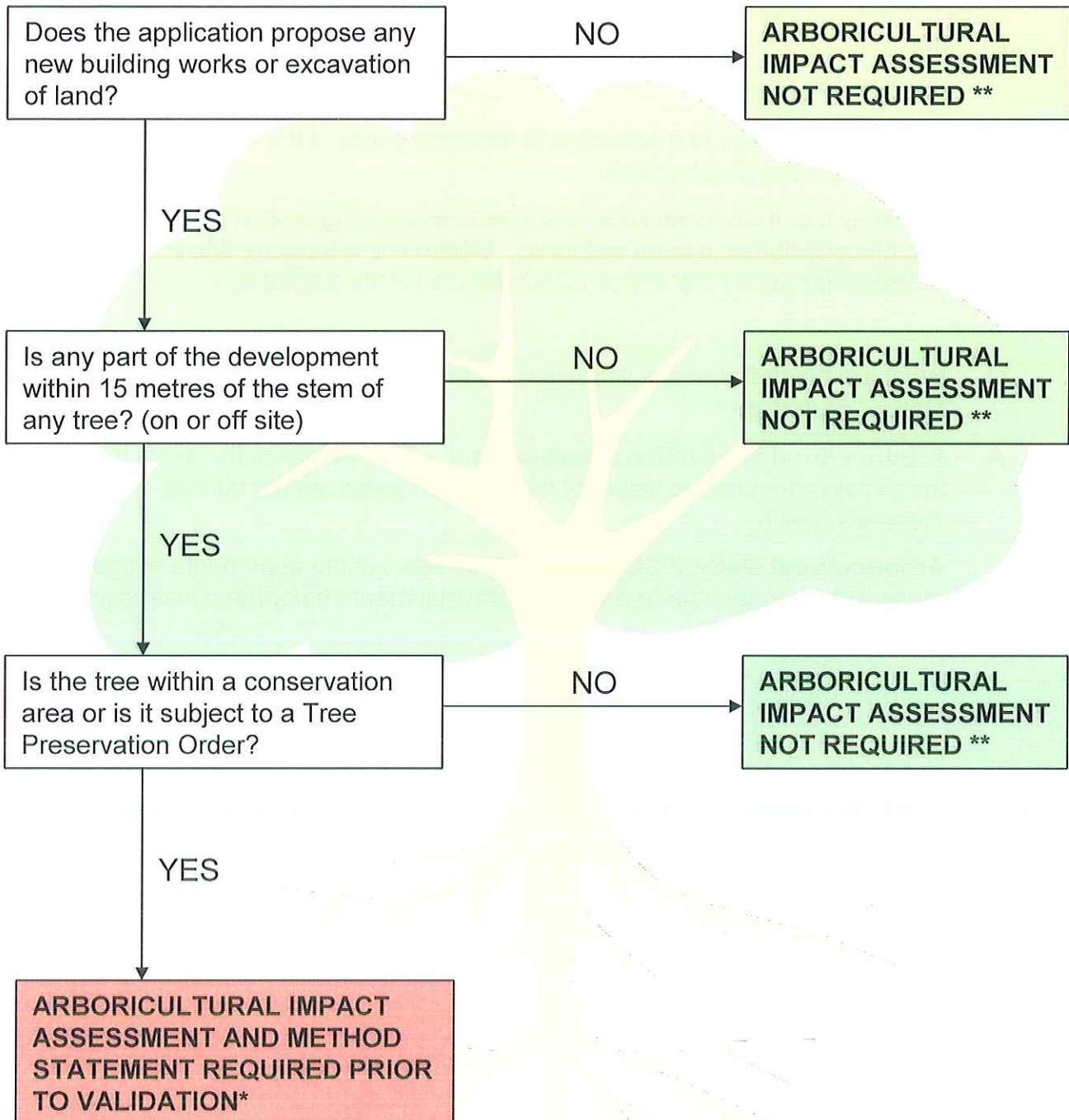


Arboricultural Validation Flow-chart



* Wherever an arboricultural impact assessment and method statement is required the arboricultural officer should be consulted

** note: this may still be required if requested within the application process

Arboricultural Validation Flow-chart

FAQ

Q. Is the stem the same as the trunk of the tree?

A. Yes

Q. What about storage of materials and machinery even if the tree is more than 15 metres from the development.

A. It is likely that if this is an issue that needs addressing as part of the application it can be conditioned in most instances. Where it is necessary this information can be asked for during the determination period for the application.

Q. What are the definitions of Arboricultural Implications Assessment & Arboricultural Method Statement?

A. **Arboricultural Implications Assessment** – This assesses the direct impacts of the development on the health of the tree and assesses the current condition of the tree's health

Arboricultural Method Statement – This sets out the appropriate mitigating measures to protect the tree from the development and/or the construction process.
