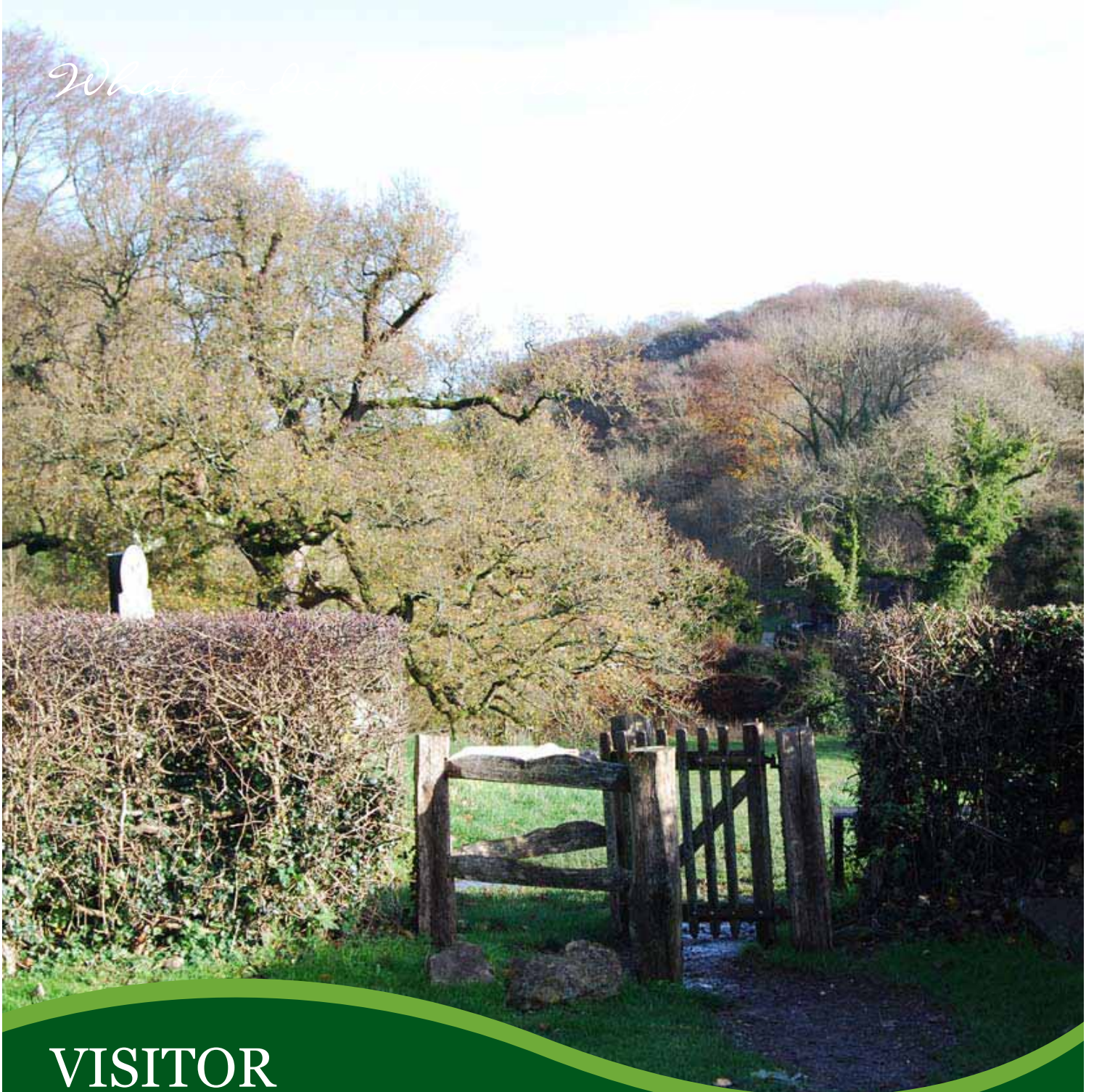

Places to Visit

There is a wide variety of exciting attractions and places to visit in the area.

Market towns and villages

Our market towns and villages are full of historical and architectural interest.

Hampshire's friendliest market town, **Alton** is a thriving country town built around a wealthy Saxon settlement. It offers a delightful mix of historic buildings jostling with modern shops and arcades, and visitors enjoy the many markets and fairs.

Chawton, just south of Alton, is the delightful village where Jane Austen lived and wrote or revised all her novels.

Set in the glorious countryside of the **South Downs**, the ancient market town of Petersfield was originally built as a Norman 'new town' at the end of the 11th Century. The main square hosts the markets on Wednesday and Saturday. The town has a vibrant artistic and musical life. Enjoy the art exhibitions and music at **Bedaes Arts** in nearby **Steep**.

Grayshott village, with air 'as pure as that in the Alps', attracted authors George Bernard Shaw and Arthur Conan Doyle, who lived in nearby Hindhead. Make time to visit Grayshott Pottery and Waggoners Wells Ponds.

'So by coach to Lippock' wrote Samuel Pepys and he described how **Liphook** became a prosperous link village in the 1650s. At Old Thorns nearby, there is a championship golf course.

With its past tradition of ale brewing, **Horndean** combines a mixture of old and new. Cycle, walk or ride through the **Queen Elizabeth Country Park** nearby. The source of the

River Meon is near the picturesque village of **East Meon**. The largest village in the Hampshire part of the South Downs, **Liss**, is on the **River Rother**, along which is a delightful easy access walk.

The attractive village of **Selborne** is famous for its association with the 18th century literary naturalist **Gilbert White**. White constructed the Zig Zag path up the **Selborne Hanger** and this forms part of a circular walk. Gilbert White's House & Garden can be visited throughout the year.

Whitehill/Bordon has recently been awarded Eco Town status and is set in heathland ecologically outstanding as a wildlife sanctuary. The area has been a centre of military importance since 1863. The **Deadwater Valley Walk** is in an area of heath and woodland rich in wildlife and easily accessible. Enjoy a full programme of events at the **Phoenix Arts Centre**, alternatively take the children to the nearby **Birdworld**, **Go Ape!** or **Alice Holt Woodland Park**.

Enjoy the tranquility of an 18th century country house in the heart of the picturesque village of Selborne. Home of the Rev. Gilbert White, the author of the world famous 'Natural History of Selbourne'. While studied and meticulously recorded the natural world around him, keeping detailed journals and corresponding with other leading naturalists of the day. He was also a keen and experimental gardener, and his home is set in a magnificent parkland, with gardens that have been largely restored to their 18th century form with elements he described and plants of his time displayed in 'Six Quarters'.

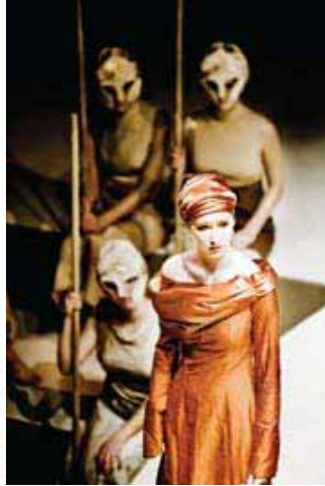

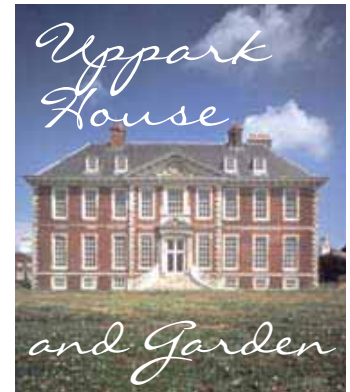

Jane Austen

Jane Austen, whose books are admired for their wit and social observation, was born and lived most of her life in Hampshire. She loved the county and it was here that she found the inspiration to write such classics as 'Pride and Prejudice', 'Emma' and 'Sense and Sensibility'.

In 1809 Jane, her sister Cassandra and their mother settled in Chawton, near Alton where you can walk the fields and country lanes which inspired her and explore her museum home.

Jane Austen's affection for Chawton is shown in the following lines:

"Our Chawton home - how much we find Already in it, to our mind, And how convinced that when complete, It will all other places beat, That ever have been made or mended, With rooms concise or rooms distended."

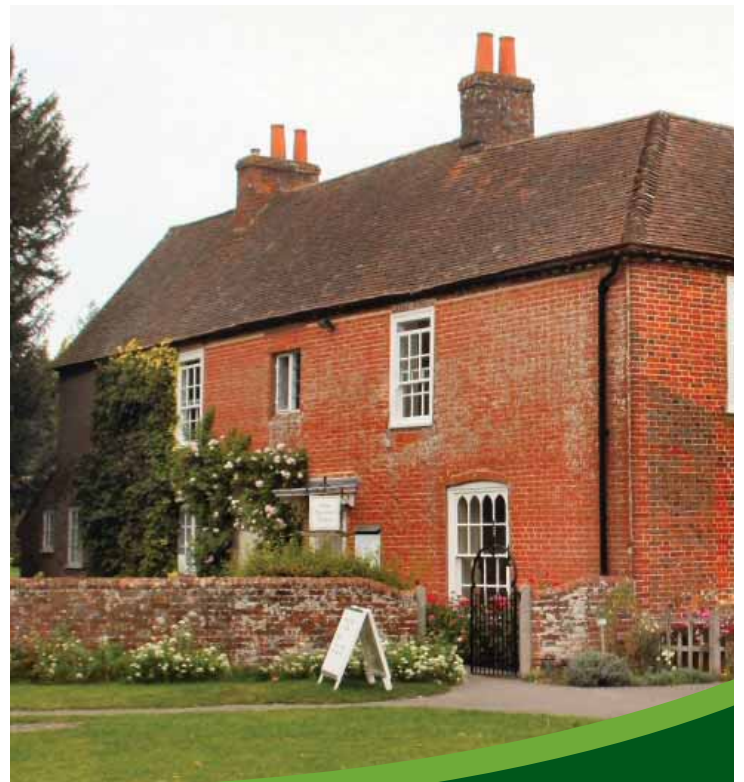

Walking

A series of circular walks, following in the footsteps of the literary greats who took inspiration from the area, can be enjoyed. **Jane Austen, Flora Thompson, Edward Thomas and Gilbert White** all feature.

Cycling

A whole range of on and off road cycle routes are waiting for you.

Off Road Cycle Packs are available from information centres to help you explore our spectacular countryside. They are mostly circular, and use the extensive Rights of Way network.

Horse Riding

The beautiful and varied countryside has a lot to offer the keen horse-rider, exploring heathland, downland or forest. Find your own space in the Queen Elizabeth Country Park with riding trails or follow some of the local cross country bridleways.

Make sure you stay in quality assured accommodation that has a star rating from either Enjoy England or the AA so you can be confident it has been checked out before you check in.

All the accommodation in this guide is quality assessed. Accommodation can be booked direct with the establishment or through the Tourist Information Centre (01730 268829).

Prices

These are quoted per person, per night sharing double/twin room for serviced accommodation; or per unit per week for self catering establishments, and cover the period 1 January to 31 December 2010.

Never has quality meant so much

When choosing your accommodation look for the Quality Rose, the official marquee of the Enjoy England national tourist board rating scheme, or the AA sign. The assessors visit every year, carrying out a routine day visit or an overnight stay. On these occasions, they book in as a guest and award a score for every aspect of the experience including the comfort of the bed, the quality of the food, cleanliness and warmth of welcome.

For self-catering accommodation, the layout of the accommodation and the range and quality of the kitchen equipment is assessed, as well as the quality and comfort of the bedrooms and bathrooms and cleanliness.

For serviced accommodation, there are two separate schemes – one for hotels and one for guest accommodation, including Bed and Breakfasts, Inns, and Restaurants with Rooms.

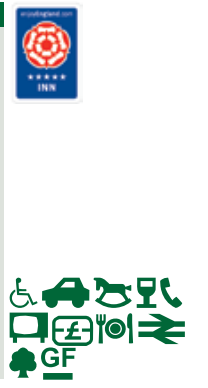

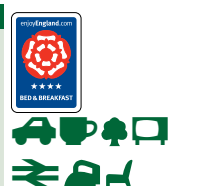

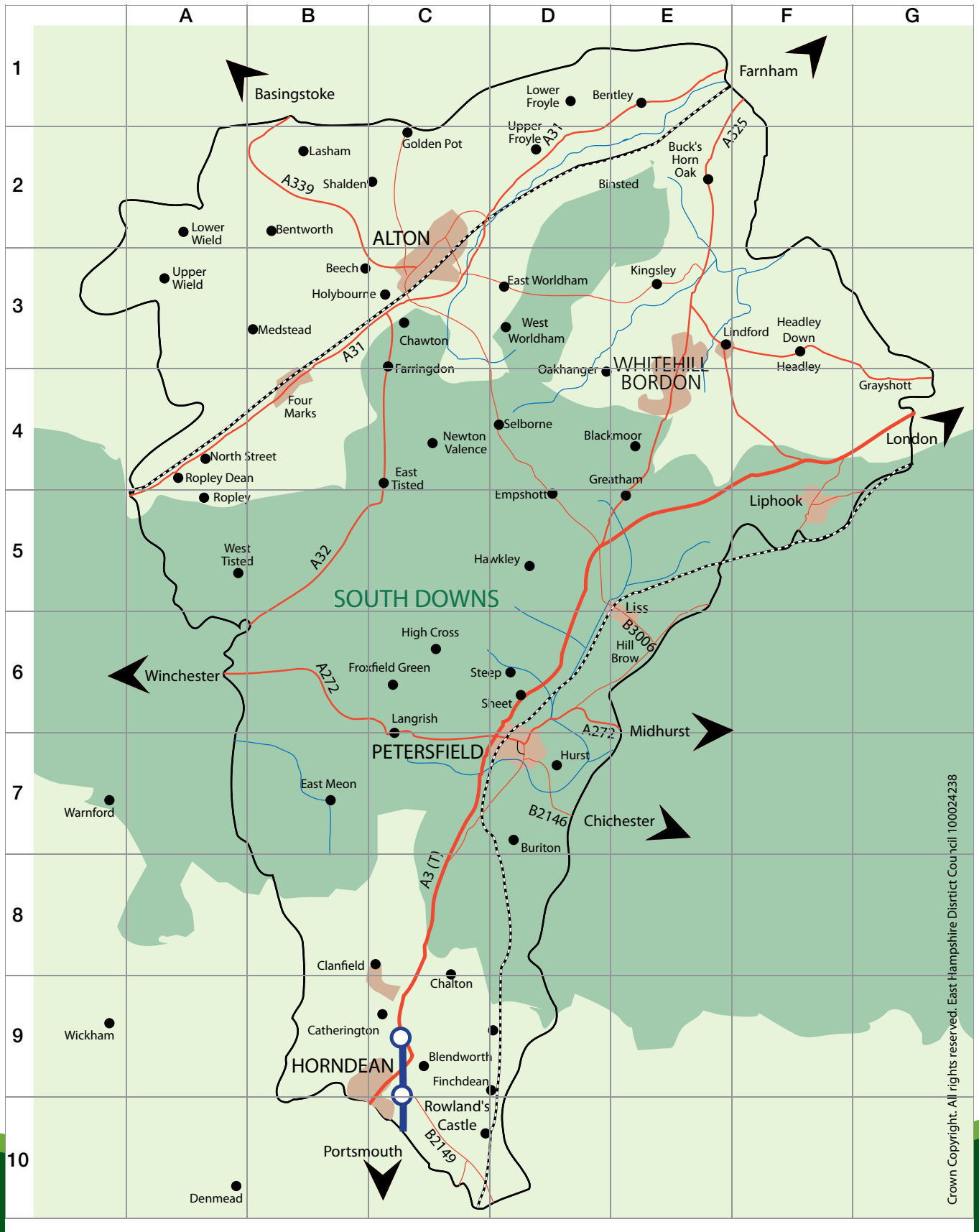
