

Buying permits (cont.)

Visitors permits are sold in books of 10 permits at a cost of £5.00 per book. Only 30 permits may be bought per household per year. These permits **do not** need to be used if your visitors are not exceeding the waiting restrictions or if they are visiting outside of the restriction times.

Operation of the scheme

East Hampshire District Council manages the issue of permits on behalf of Hampshire County Council

Enforcement of the scheme

The scheme is enforced by the Police. Breach of the parking restrictions may result in the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice by Hampshire Constabulary.

The onus is on the permit holder to ensure that their permit is clearly displayed at all times.

All appeals against on-street Penalty Charge Notices must be referred to the Police. East Hampshire District Council has no jurisdiction in these matters.

- proof of residency (i.e. council tax bill)

The Petersfield On-Street Parking Scheme.

Who is entitled to a permit?

Any householder living in one of the roads listed below is entitled to purchase one or two annual permits as indicated and 30 visitors permits per year.

The majority of roads in the scheme are not exclusive for residential parking. Short term parking by non-residents is allowed.

Residents that purchase a permit are exempt from any restrictions, but a permit does not guarantee the availability of a space.

Blue (Disabled) Badge Holders are exempt from any waiting restrictions and do not require a permit providing that their Blue Badge is displayed.

Key to Zones

- Zone 1** 2 Hour Limited Waiting, 9 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, Permit Holders Exempt
- Zone 2** 1 Hour Limited Waiting, 9 am to 6 pm Monday to Saturday, Permit Holders Exempt.
- Zone 3** Permit Holders Only

Please note

Residents Parking permits cannot be used in EHDC car parks. All vehicles parked in these car parks must display a valid ticket. Residents entitled to two permits will have their entitlement reduced to one permit if their property has its own off street parking.

Buying permits

Annual Residents Permits cost £25 per permit and can be purchased at any time. Permits must be displayed in the windscreen of your vehicle and are valid for one year from the time of purchase.

You are required to provide one or two car registration numbers, these will be quoted on your permit. The vehicle(s) listed must be registered to the household applying for the permit.

When renewing an expired permit, the new permit will be back dated to the date the old one expired. Every effort will be made to issue permits within 2 working days of receipt of the application.
