## **May '10 Round-Up...**

### **PRESENTATION - THE GREENING CAMPAIGN.**

Ms Terena Plowright of the Greening Campaign gave a short presentation on the work of the Greening Campaign.

### **PRESENTATION – THE SHIPWRIGHTS WAY.**

The Shipwrights Way was planned to be a multi user route for walkers, cyclists, and where possible, horse riders and wheelchair users.

Two routes had been prepared, one that could be easily and quickly implemented and a longer term 'aspirational' route that would require more major work, over a period of up to around five years.

One of the key considerations of the route had been the amenity of users, with regard to the visual amenity of the user's surroundings, noise levels, and the surface on which they would be walking.

## **Dragon's Den at TPS**

Pupils from Sheet, Buriton and Langrish primary schools were under the spotlight in the Dragons Den as part of the Figure It Out! Maths project at The Petersfield School in June.

Each group of pupils designed a product or event which they would like to market or run. They brought their initial ideas, a prototype and costings to the "Dragon's Den" in the Studio at The Petersfield School, where a panel of older TPS students examined their ideas, just like on the TV show.

One Dragon, Tom Best commented, "It was interesting how one pupil said that they already knew the maths, but they just didn't realise they knew it!"

### **Liss infants taught how to help the environment**

Liss children learnt how to save the world when they were visited by environmental experts.

The team from the Environment Centre, a not-for-profit charity which promotes sustainable lifestyles, came to Liss Infant School as part of its eco-week.

The children were taught about the value of local shopping, growing food at home, saving power, walking to school and a host of other ways to live in a more environmentally-friendly way.

Laura James, of the Environment Centre, based in Southampton, said:

"Children at this age are very, very receptive and really want to do things that are good and help the planet."
