## **Youngsters help design first eco-home**

Pupils from Bordon Junior School are working with award-winning architects to help design Whitehill Bordon's first eco-home.

The school has a group of 'eco-warriors' who are responsible for helping to save energy by ensuring computers and lights are turned off in classrooms.

These eco-warriors, aged between seven and 11, were enlisted by the London-based architectural firm Riches, Hawley, Mikhail who are designing the carbon-busting home on behalf of the Whitehill Bordon Opportunity group at the disused Fire Station.

They have visited the site recently and will soon be putting pen to paper and drawing their ideal eco-home.

The architects may incorporate some of these ideas into their final design.

Michele Frost, Headteacher at Bordon Junior School, said: "The pupils are excited about the Eco-town and they are jumping at any opportunity to get involved.

"Designing and building the first eco home is particularly interesting for them because they will see how their ideas evolve into the actual building of the home"
