# January Round up

## **DEVELOPMENT BRIEF: LOWSLEY FARM, LIPHOOK.**

The Forum received an update from The Planning Policy Team Leader. He explained that the Council had not made any decision to release the Local Plan reserve sites for development. The purpose of the Development Brief was to ensure that, if an application to develop one of these sites was either granted planning permission by EHDC, or refused but subsequently granted by a Planning Inspector, such as at Silent Garden in Liphook, the development would not undermine the achievement of any planning objectives. The development brief was adopted as non-statutory planning guidance, subject to some minor amendments.

## **PRESENTATION – EAST HAMPSHIRE YOUTH COUNCIL.**

Mrs Lara Nolan, Youth Council Support Worker and Elin Thomas, Secretary of the East Hampshire Youth Council updated the Forum on the work of the East Hampshire Youth Council over the past six months.

## **PRESENTATION – HANDYPERSON SCHEME.**

Mrs Clare Cox, Senior Case Worker for the East Hampshire Home Improvement Agency gave a short presentation on the Handyerson Scheme, which started in August 2009.

## **DEVELOPER CONTRIBUTIONS FOR OPEN SPACE: BIENNIAL UPDATE AND PARISH SPENDING PROPOSALS.**

The Forum noted the amount of Developer Contributions for open space available as at 31<sup>st</sup> October 2009.

## **USE OF DEVELOPER CONTRIBUTIONS – LINDFORD AND HEADLEY.**

The Forum approved the following bids for Developer Contributions:

- Lindford Parish Council – up to £12,200 to allow the completion of the refurbishment of

the children's play area at Lindford Triangle;

- Lindford Parish Council – up to £800 towards the provision of a new bench and dog waste bin on open space at The Chase; and
- Headley Parish Council – up to £2,000 towards the provision of new cricket practice nets on the sports field in Mill Lane, Headley.

## **Funding still available for youth project – but the deadline looms!**

Young people in the district can get their hands on a share of £5,000 to help fund their own projects - but they must hurry as the deadline for applications is Friday 19 March.

Money Pot, run by the 14 to 17-year-old members of East Hampshire Youth Council, hands out grants of up to £250 for organisations working with young people.

The Money Pot will close at the end of March 2010 but if the scheme uses the £5,000 allocated for this year it will be likely to carry on.
