Rural Crime

The main theme for the meeting was rural crime and Karen Dawes, Community Safety Manager introduced the Forum to a new website called Crime Reports (www.crimereports.co.uk) which enabled people to see what crimes had occurred in their area.

Police Community Safety Officer (PCSO) Becky Veal for Country Watch gave a brief talk to the Forum.

Country Watch was split into three geographical policing areas and concentrated on poaching, fly tipping, rural theft and anti-social driving.

The meeting undertook a short exercise to highlight what rural crimes people knew were happening in their areas.

The Forum worked as groups for fifteen minutes to look at maps on their tables and placed a sticky dot on places they may have reason to believe something suspicious was happening such as poaching or anti-social driving.

The responses would be collated by the Community Safety Manager and passed on to the Police.

Have your say on police budgets in online survey



Hampshire Police Authority has launched an online survey to give the public the power to influence the policing budget for 2012/13.

Residents from Hampshire and the Isle of Wight are being encouraged to share their views and opinions on the allocation of the policing budget and their policing priorities.

Councillor Jacqui Rayment, Chair of Hampshire Police Authority, said: "The Authority has always been led by the views and opinions of the residents of Hampshire and the Isle of Wight.

"The results of the survey will be used to help shape the future policing services for Hampshire and the Isle of Wight and we welcome your views."

The survey, which can be done anonymously, asks questions about how safe people feel, whether they have been the victim of crime, and gives the opportunity to say whether Hampshire Constabulary should be spending more or less money in key budget areas.
