PRESENTATION – EAST HAMPSHIRE YOUTH COUNCIL

Mrs Lara Nolan, Youth Council Support Worker, Jake Topp, Chairman of the East Hampshire Youth Council and Hannah How, a Youth Councillor updated the Forum on the work of the East Hampshire Youth Council over the past six months.

COMMUNITY INITIATIVES FUND APPLICATION, LISS

The Forum recommended to Cabinet the following bid:

Liss Parish Council - £5,000 towards the building of a skate bowl at Centenary Gardens, Liss.

PRESENTATION – GET ACTIVE

Mrs Sarah Walker, East Hampshire Cycling Development Officer gave a short presentation on the Get Active Campaign.

PRESENTATION – WHEELS TO WORK

Miss Sarah Hobbs, Community Access Officer, gave a presentation on the Wheels to Work scheme.

USE OF DEVELOPER CONTRIBUTIONS: PETERSFIELD

The Forum agreed the following bids to use Developer Contributions:

- Petersfield Town Council – up to £20,000 towards the Skate Park project at Love Lane, Petersfield;
- Petersfield Tomorrow – ring-fencing up to £20,000 to use as part of an economic development project at Lavant Street, Petersfield; and
- East Hampshire District Council – up to £20,975 towards a new play site at Rival Moor Road, Petersfield.

DEVELOPER CONTRIBUTIONS FOR OPEN SPACE: BIENNIAL UPDATE AND PARISH SPENDING PROPOSALS

The Forum noted the total Developer Contributions for open space available as at 31st October 2009.

HISTORIC BUILDING GRANT

The Forum agreed a bid of £1,000 towards window repairs at Hebbardens, Lower Bordean, Petersfield.

EHDC FUNDING REVIEW

The Forum noted changes to the funding process as agreed by Cabinet in November 2009.
