### Workshop on the New Format of Community Forums

Mike O'Mahony, Team Leader - Community Services, displayed the new mini-web whereby individuals and groups could access a form to submit a project or issue. It was currently under development and it would store historic data as to how a project/issue progressed from start to finish enabling this information to be shared with other people who may have a similar project/issue. It might be apparent that there are common issues in neighbourhoods and by working together, it could provide a stronger base for sharing solutions.

#### Community Project Fund

**Hampshire County Council: £1,000** towards the 'Youth Voice' project;

**Deadwater Valley Trust: £1,000** towards the enhancement of Knox's Pond;

**Grayshott Parish Council: £1,000** towards the refurbishment of Grayshott Sports Pavilion;

**The Peak Trust, Liphook: £1,000** towards the running of a day centre for elderly people.

#### Use of Developer Contributions: Grayshott

**Up to £27,000** towards the refurbishment of Grayshott Pavilion.
