PRESENTATION – OAK PARK COMMUNITY HOSPITAL.

Mrs Inger Hebden, Director of Capital Planning, NHS Hampshire gave a presentation about the review of the Oak Park Community Hospital by NHS Hampshire.

DEVELOPMENT BRIEF: GREEN LANE, CLANFIELD.

The Planning Policy Team Leader introduced the report. He reminded the Forum that the Draft Development Brief had been considered by the Forum in July 2009. The Forum had agreed that it should be sent out for public consultation. The public consultation had lasted for eight weeks, this had been because it had covered the summer holiday period. During the consultation period there had been a public meeting organised by the Parish Council and 80 respondents had replied to the

consultation. These responses had been included within the document.

Following discussions it was resolved that the development brief as set out in the report, with the amendment agreed, be adopted as non-statutory planning guidance.

USE OF DEVELOPER CONTRIBUTIONS: HORNDEAN.

The Forum agreed the following application:

- Up to £800 for the provision of additional fencing at Downs Park, Horndean, subject to the conditions set out in paragraph 2.3 of the report.

COMMUNITY PROJECT FUND (ONE-OFF PROJECT COSTS).

The Forum awarded the follow grant:

- £1,290 to Finchdean Chapel (United Reformed Church) towards the costs of chairs, heaters and tables.
