## **COMMUNITY PROJECT FUND APPLICATIONS**

The Forum awarded the following applications:

- £1,922.67 – Grayshott Concerts, towards staging for village projects and the surrounding area.
- £2,000 – 1<sup>st</sup> Headley Scout Group, towards refurbishing the centre where the group meets.
- £978.12 – Alexandra Pre-School, towards the renaming of the group to "Little Otters" and relocation expenses incurred in relation to the group moving to Lindford Village Hall.

## **COMMUNITY PROJECT FUND REVENUE APPLICATIONS**

The following Community Project Fund Revenue applications were approved:

- £1,953 – Whitehill and Bordon Community Association – Forest Fun Club Summer Playscheme; and
- £996.45 – Movies in Grayshott, towards showing films at Grayshott Village Hall.

## **HISTORIC BUILDING GRANTS 2008 - 2009.**

The following bid for a historic building grant was deferred to a future meeting:

- £1,000 – towards repairs and replacement of the thatch at Overton Cottage, Headley.

## **USE OF DEVELOPER CONTRIBUTIONS: BIENNIAL UPDATE**

## **USE OF DEVELOPER CONTRIBUTIONS**

The following applications to use Developer Contributions were approved:

- £1,850 – Whitehill Town Council, improvement to the skate park, Budds Lane, Bordon;
- £7,000 – Lindford Parish Council, provision of a play area, Lindford Village Hall;
- £1,145 – Lindford Parish Council, improvement of the play area at the Triangle, Lindford; and
- £10,000 – Headley Parish Council, for major upgrade of playing pitches, Heatherlands, Headley Down.
