Amendment to Page 41, Paragraph 6.4.10

6.4.10 So, excluding 2,725 dwellings at Whitehill & Bordon, approximately 2,258 2,605 new residents can be expected as a worst case within 5km of the SPA as a result of additional uncommitted housing being proposed in the East Hampshire & South Downs National Park Joint Core Strategy and Waverley Core Strategy and windfalls, or a population increase of approximately 3.5% 4.1%. One can broadly calculate that a 3.5% 4.1% increase in residents within 5km could equate to an increase in visitors to the SPA of a similar order of magnitude.

Amendment to Page 41, Paragraph 6.4.11

6.4.11 Even when considered 'in combination' with those committed dwellings that have planning permission but have not yet been delivered the fitures are still modest. There are 622 un-built commitment dwellings (ie. Those with planning permission) at Liphook, Liss, Grayshott and Whitehill & Bordon in addition to the 846 1,099 uncommitted dwellings, which raises the overall housing figure to 1,468 1,721. However, this would still be an increase in residents of just over 5% 6.4% compared to current levels.
