Background

Schedule 12 of the Gambling Act 2005 www.gamblingcommission.gov.uk.

Application

In all the following cases the application must be made on the prescribed form available from the Licensing Office or by downloading from the Council website.

1. For applicants who are registered under Part 2 or Part 3 of the Gaming Act 1968

The form must be accompanied by:

- the Part 2/Part 3 certificate
- £100

A copy of the application and certificate must be sent to the Gambling Commission and the Police within a period of 7 days beginning on the date on which the application is made.

2. For applicants who is a holder of a club premises certificate under section 72 of the Licensing Act 2003

The form must be accompanied by:

• £100

A copy of the application and certificate must be sent to the Gambling Commission and the Police with a period of 7 days beginning on the date on which the application is made.

3. New applicants

The form must be accompanied by:

• £200

A copy of the application must be sent to the Gambling Commission and the Police within a period of 7 days beginning on the date on which the application is made.

- 4. An application to RENEW a permit must be accompanied by a copy of that permit.
 - Must be accompanied by a fee of £200
