THIS NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following parish:  
HORNDEAN

Has applied to East Hampshire District Council and the South Downs National Park Authority for designation of a Neighbourhood Plan Area under Part 2 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012.

Horndean Parish Council as the 'relevant body' submitted an application for designation of a neighbourhood area to East Hampshire District Council and the South Downs National Park Authority. The specified area includes the whole of the parish boundary. The submission included a) a map identifying the area, b) a statement explaining why the area is considered an appropriate neighbourhood and c) a statement that the organisation making the application is a relevant body, as required by Regulation 5 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012.

In determining a neighbourhood area application, East Hampshire District Council must consider the following:

The desirability of designating the whole of the area of a parish council as a neighbourhood area; and	The parish is partially within East Hampshire District Council and the South Downs National Park. The application is to designate the entire parish as a neighbourhood area in both East Hampshire District Council and the South Downs National Park Authority. This is considered appropriate.
The desirability of maintaining the existing boundaries or areas already designated as a neighbourhood area.	This is the first area designation application in Horndean Parish, so in determining this application no other existing designated boundaries are impacted.
